Should a student wish to register for both weekends, the fee will be \$100 for both weekends. Registrations must be submitted at the same time.

Normal registration fees of \$60 per person applies for each weekend if submitted separately.

Introduction to Basic Firemanship

16 Hours

This course is designed to cover the subjects in which an individual will encounter in the fire service. It also will introduce the student to skills they will be required to perform as a firefighter. Class will also include Electrical Emergencies and Introduction to Safety and the Training System. A Butler County certificate will be issued.

Pump Operations I (PUOP)

16 Hours

This course provides the firefighter with an introduction to basic pump construction and theory, as well as operating techniques. Emphasis is placed on getting water to the pump, getter water from the pump for hose streams and prevention of common mistakes in pump operations.

Emergency Vehicle Operator Training (EVOT) 16 Hours

A large number of emergency service personnel and civilians are injured and killed each year as a result of inappropriately driven emergency vehicles. Participants in this course will have the opportunity to gain and/or verify a broad range of competencies associated with the emergency vehicle driving. These competencies include basic understanding of emergency vehicle operations as well as the skills necessary for practical and safe application of driving on a competency course.

PRE-REQUISITES: Must be 18 years old on first day of class & possess a

valid drivers license

Truck Company Operations (TRCO)

16 Hours

Truck companies, regardless of whether they arrive on an aerial device, squad, or engine, are the "combat engineers" of fire attack operations. This course, for experienced firefighters, will introduce the student to the basic concept of truck company operations and duties, including organizing the delivery of truck company services, selection and use of key tools, advanced ventilation and forcible entry theory and practices, search and rescue, and other fire attack support functions.

PRE-REQUISITES: ELIF or EBM or FF I certification

CLASS LIMIT: 30 students

Firefighter Survival (SURV)

16 Hours

This course is a physically demanding, comprehensive program dealing with the necessary knowledge and skills relative to rescue procedures needed for self rescue. Emphasis will be placed on search techniques, communications, accountability/location and self rescue procedures. Student must by physically able to crawl, climb and descend ladders, slide on rope and SUPPORT OWN BODY WEIGHT WHILE HANGING BY ARMS.

PRE-REQUISITES: ELIF or EBM or FFI

Recommended RITC, SFR and ICS.

Highway Incident Scene Safety and Traffic Management (HSTC)

16 Hours

The primary target audiences for this course are Fire, Fire Police, rescue, EMS and law enforcement personnel who command, respond to or work at highway incidents. Allied professionals such as transportation / highway maintenance and emergency management personnel can also benefit from attendance. Students will learn how to adapt the same safety and traffic control principles used to establish work zones in the highway construction and maintenance industries. They will be shown ways of applying these principles, using limited equipment and staffing, to enhance safety at emergency incidents on streets and highways. Topics covered include scene assessment, risk management, regulatory issues of temporary traffic control, necessary equipment, flagging, and personnel safety procedures. Practical exercises are included that let students apply what they have leamed to "real world" incident scenarios.

Advanced Structure Burn Session (SBS)

19 Hours

This course will provide the student with a review and application of the techniques used in safe firefighting practices in an actual fire environment. Emphasis is placed on safety for both interior and exterior operations.

Incident Safety Officer (ISO)

16 Hours

This course is designed for fire and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) responders who may be designated by the Incident Commander (IC) as an ISO while working within an Incident Command System (ICS). These assignments may occur during firefighting, EMS, special-operations-type incidents, and training evolutions. This course is an incident-specific, scenario-oriented course designed to teach students what an ISO needs to know at an incident.

Rescue Group Overnight Wilderness Challenge

16 Hours

Is your team of four up for an overnight challenge in the wilderness? In the morning you will learn about the wilderness and how to survive. In the afternoon you will move out into the woods and practice what you learned. After dinner, you will move to the woods and setup for an overnight stay. There will be three categories: Novice, Intermediate and Advanced. Depending upon the category you choose will dictate the challenges you will face.
